Dear parents and carers,

GCSE PE Rock Climbing Trip

The Physical Education Department have arranged a rock-climbing trip in September 2021 for GCSE students. This trip is being offered as an opportunity for those students who do not currently have three sports (at least one being an individual sport) to be assessed in. The intensive course will take place at the Kent Scouts Activity Centre, Lower Grange Farm, Maidstone.

The trip will run from Monday to Wednesday. The first two days are training days, with assessments taking place on the Wednesday. On these days, students will need to arrive at school by 7.45am and will return at around 4pm, with an earlier return time on their assessment day. Students will be expected to return to normal lessons on their return on the Wednesday.

The cost of the trip is £90. If you would like your child to have the opportunity to attend, a deposit of £45 will be required by 17 June, via ParentPay. The balance of the trip will be payable by 3 September. Unfortunately, any cancellation within two weeks of the trip cannot be refunded.

A student will not be excluded from this trip if, due to financial hardship, parents or carers are unable to contribute. If this is applicable, or if you experience any difficulty accessing your ParentPay account, please contact the Finance Department on financequeries@wealdgs.org.
