During these appointments, you will be able to discuss your child's academic progress with their subject teachers. It is expected that all students attend the virtual appointments with their parents. Please note, it is important to log on in plenty of time as the system we are using automatically times appointments out at the end of your slot.

This link will be going live on Thursday 16 September from 9am and the booking system will close at 23.55pm on 20 September.

Each parent is able to log in separately to this system. Where teachers have requested to see a parent/carer, this appointment will be made with the main contact person listed on our school's system. In all cases, emails will be sent to confirm appointments. You may wish to check your 'Junk mail', if an email does not appear in your inbox.

Please note that it may not be possible to see all of your child's teachers. If an appointment is not available, but should you like feedback from a teacher, staff will be happy to call or email you personally.
