

Please note however, that the trip can only run if it receives adequate financial support from parents.

Coaches will leave each school campus promptly at 9am and to allow students enough time in the park, we will be leaving Thorpe Park by 4pm and expect to return to school, at the latest, by 6pm. Therefore, alternative arrangements will need to be made for your child to get home. Students should, if possible, bring their mobile phone in order to contact you when we have a confirmed arrival time back at school.
