### **Year 13 Pre-Public Examinations Arrangements (PPEs)**

We are writing to update you on the arrangements for the forthcoming Pre-Public Examinations (PPEs) which will run from Monday 5 January to Friday 16 January 2026 inclusive.

All students will be on study leave for the duration of their PPEs. Students are therefore not expected in school (unless they have a PPE) from Monday 5 January and lessons will restart on Tuesday 20 January due to the INSET day on Monday 19 January. Students are able to remain in school if they have both a morning and an afternoon exam. Otherwise, students are expected to be in school for their PPEs only.

The PPEs provide students with an opportunity to practice examination techniques and the timing of questions in high control conditions. Students should act on the guidance provided by their subject teachers to ensure they revise effectively and are prepared for January.

We will communicate the PPE timetables via our system, 'SchoolWorkSpace'. Both you and your child will be sent a link via email to access their individual PPE timetable this week. The seating can change regularly in the run up to examinations, therefore, please encourage them to check their seating allocation the night before each exam.

Our main examination venues are the Sports Hall on either campus, whether for PPEs or summer examinations. Please note that provision for access arrangements may be either in these same venues or in different rooms in line with the particular needs of students. The SENCO or member of the Learning Support team will be communicating these out separately by early December.

An assembly will be delivered to all Year 13 students to reiterate the expectations, conduct and regulations required for practice and actual public examinations in advance of both the PPEs and the summer series of examinations. Please see the 'Exams' area on our school website, in the section entitled '[Information for Candidates 2025-26](#)', for more information and guidance that we are required to make available to all students.

You will be able to discuss subject progress and areas for development at the Year 13 Parents and Carers' Consultation Evening on 9 December 2025.

These breakdowns will be important for reference when comparing results with raw mark boundaries on exam board websites in the event of any Review of Results requests.
