Women working in Finance

This resource was forwarded to students from an Independent Financial Adviser at Sterling & Law, based in Tunbridge Wells, who is passionate about encouraging more young women to consider a career in financial services - a sector where women are still significantly underrepresented (only 18% of financial planners are women, despite 60% of advice clients being female).

The Women's Wealth Alliance Career Guide is a female-focused guide covering the range of roles in personal finance. Financial planning, paraplanning, mortgage and protection advice, financial coaching, compliance and more, with realistic entry routes (including school-leaver and apprenticeship pathways, not just university routes), salary bands, and first-hand accounts from women in the profession.
