			classes may be in the sports hall as they are

Poor workplace ventilation leading to risks of coronavirus spreading	16	•	PE lessons will be held outside as long as the ground conditions are safe enough. If a lesson has to take place in the sports hall, all fire exits will be open to encourage air flow through the hall. Students will wear PE kit to school so no need to use the changing rooms. If their kit gets wet and they have to change at the end of the lesson, students will be spread out between the changing rooms to ensure social distancing is maintained. The sports hall can also be used for changing provided there is a PE teacher standing outside the door to make sure nobody goes in.	9	October Half term	PE staff
