14th & 15th January 2021 - Human Papilloma Virus (HPV) Vaccination in school – DOSE 2

The Kent and Medway Immunisation Service will be visiting your son / daughter's school on the date above to administer **dose two** of the Human Papillomavirus (HPV) vaccination.

If you have previously consented for your son/daughter to receive HPV Dose One:

You are not required to give consent again as you will already have consented when your son/daughter received dose one.

If you declined consent for HPV Dose One:

If you declined consent for dose one this will remain as declined for dose two. However, please note that a young person can consent to having an immunisation if they are assessed as competent to do so. For more information about consent please go to: www.nhs.uk/chq/pages/900.aspx

If your son/daughter did not receive dose One in Year 8:

If your son / daughter did not received dose one of their HPV vaccination in YR8, and you would like them to be vaccinated please complete the online consent form marking whether you consent or decline consent at www.kentcht.nhs.uk/imms before **10th January 2021**.

To access the consent form you will need to enter your son / daughter's school unique reference number (URN) which is below

This vaccination is not routinely given at your GP surgery but if for medical reasons we are unable to vaccinate your child a referral will be completed and a copy will be sent to you.
