## **Supported Testing for students under 12**

For children under 12, tests will need to be carried out by an adult. We would strongly recommend using the asymptomatic test centres, who are much better equipped to support you with this.

If your child is under child 12 and you are unable to get an asymptomatic test, please email <a href="mailto:school@wealdgs.org">school@wealdgs.org</a> so we can make arrangements for you.

# What to expect on the day: Tonbridge Campus

• Students should enter the Sports Hall via the Sports Hall cark park entrance (as this entrance will be used for pedestrians on the day of testing we cannot provide parking, instead please use the layby, the Vauxhall Inn's Car Park, or park at Sainsbury's and walk up to school.)

- Uniform will not be required to be worn as students will only be at school for the duration of the test which will be between 10 and 20 minutes.
- There will be a one-way system in place students will enter the campus via the Sports Hall and will leave via the main entrance to ensure social distancing is maintained throughout the process.
- Students will complete the test on themselves by using a swab from each nostril (we will not be asking students to take a sample from the back of the mouth).
- Parents will not be allowed into the testing centres on the school site, if you wish to accompany your child I would recommend using the asymptomatic test centres.
- Results will only be shared if the result is positive, if you do not hear from us within 1 hour of your test you can assume a negative result.

## What to expect on the day: Sevenoaks Campus

- Students should enter the school via the main reception. Parents and careers should park and wait in the car park provided at the campus.
- There will be a one-way system in place students will enter the test centre via the main entrance and will leave via the Sports Hall exit adjacent to our all-weather pitch.
- Uniform will not be required to be worn as students will only be at school for the duration of the test which will be between 10 and 20 minutes.
- Students will complete the test on themselves by using a swab from each nostril (we will not be asking students to take a sample from the back of the mouth).
- Parents will not be allowed into the testing centres on the school site, if you wish to accompany your child I would recommend using the asymptomatic test centres.
- Results will only be shared if the result is positive, if you do not hear from us within 1 hour of your test you can assume a negative result.

### **Follow up Testing**

After each child's first test at school, we are required to test students twice more in school before parents and students can start to test at home. These tests will take place daily by year group and by form during the school day. Only those students for whom we have consent will be tested, if you wish to continue using an asymptomatic test centre, please do not give consent for your child and instead please continue to complete the form above to allow us to record the results.

#### **Guidance for Students**

Key information on what to expect and how to complete testing be will be shared with all students via their form tutors on Friday morning, to ensure students are as prepared as they can be for their return to school.
